A memorial fund has been set up in her honor at Children's Diagnostic & Treatment Center.

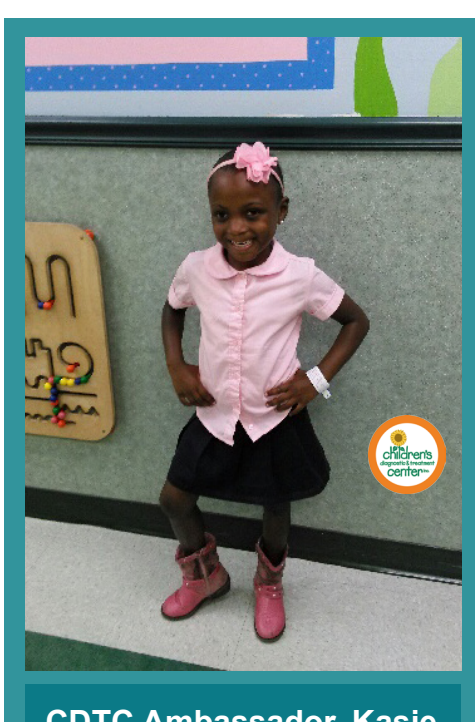

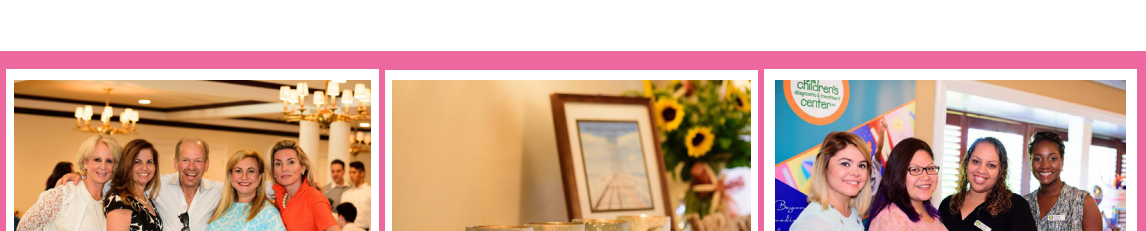
